INVITATION FOR BIDS

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received a Grant from Global Agriculture Food Security Program (GAFSP) through Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Emergency Food Assistance Project (EFAP-Additional Financing), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to payments under the Contract No. EFAP (AF)-NCB-Fertilizer-14-02, for procurement of a total quantity of 479.775 Metric Tons of DAP and 723.475 Metric Tons of UREA.
2. The Ministry of Economy and Finance, through the Central Project Management Unit (CPMU)/EFAP, now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for tender No.: EFAP (AF)-NCB-Fertilizer-14-02, Procurement of 479.775 Metric Tons of DAP and 723.475 Metric Tons of UREA consisting of two Lots as below.

Lot 1	258,825 Kilograms of Di-Ammonium Phosphate (DAP) and 390,575 Kilograms of UREA	to be delivered to 33 communes in Kampong Speu, Takeo, Svay Rieng and Prey Veng Provinces.
Lot 2	220,950 Kilograms of Di-Ammonium Phosphate (DAP) and 332,900 Kilograms of UREA	to be delivered to 22 communes in Kampong Cham, Kampong Thom, Siem Reap, Oddar Meanchey, Preah Vihear and Banteay Meanchey Provinces.

Bids may be submitted for one Lot or combination of Lots while separate contracts may be awarded for single Lot or combination of Lots to bidders who submit bid(s) that resulted in the lowest evaluated bid price(s) and subject to meet the qualification criteria set forth under Sub-Clause ITB 14.2.

3. Procurement will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedures and under the laws and regulations governing public procurement within the Kingdom of Cambodia.
4. This invitation is open to all eligible bidders from eligible source countries as described in Clause 6.1 under Special Condition of Contract (SCC) in the Bidding Document.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:30 to 11:30 and 14:30 to 17:00 on weekdays.
6. Qualification requirements include:
 - (a) Copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration, and principal place of business evidencing legal status in an eligible source country as defined in GCC Sub-Clause 6.1.
 - (b) In the case of a bidder offering to supply goods under the contract which the bidder do not manufacture or otherwise produce, the bidder has been duly authorized by the goods' manufacturer or producer to supply the goods in Cambodia;
 - (c) The bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following experience and financial requirements:
 - i. that the bidder has satisfactorily completed at least two contracts for supply of similar goods in the preceding three years or not less than 50% of the bid price in each contract.
 - ii. that the bidder has completed contracts in the total accumulative amount equal to at least two time the value of bid price in the preceding two years.

iii. that the bidder has availability of liquid assets through either:

- access to a line of credit or cash in a bank account of an amount at least 50% of the bid price, net of other contractual commitments;

OR

- credit terms with vendors specifically for the goods to be supplied under the contract, and valid for at least 6 months after the deadline for submission of bids specified in ITB Clause 21.

Sub-contractors' qualifications shall not be taken into account in establishing the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract.

- (d) that, in the case of a Bidder not doing business within Cambodia, the Bidder is or will be (if awarded the contract) represented by an agent in Cambodia equipped and able to carry out the Supplier's maintenance, repair, and spare parts stocking obligations described in the Conditions of Contract and/or Technical Specifications;
 - (e) that the Bidder gives to the Purchaser the authority to seek references from the bidder's bankers; and
 - (f) that the bidder meets the other additional qualification criteria:
 - (1). Goods are quality brands certified by Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries in Cambodia and
 - (2). Goods are tested and suitable for local soil and climatic conditions and has been traded in Cambodia for at least three running years.
7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address given below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **50 US Dollars** or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being **200,000.00 Riels**. The method of payment will be in cash. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person at the discretion of the bidder. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for purchase of the bidding documents.
8. In case of any difficulty in purchase of the bidding documents, interested parties may contact in writing H.E Vong Sandap, Project Director, at house No. 17, St. 75, Sangkat Wat Phnom, Khan Daun Penh and also send a copy of the communication to the Department of Investment and Cooperation of the Ministry of Economy and Finance located at St. 90, Sangkat Wat Phnom, Khan Daun Penh, Cambodia.
9. Bids must be delivered to the address given below at or before **10:00 am on 03 October 2014**. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives and the project's beneficiaries from the concerned local community who choose to attend shall be allowed to be present in person at the address given below at **10:00 am on 03 October 2014**.
10. All bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration as described in the Instructions to Bidders.
11. The Government of Cambodia and/or the Asian Development Bank will respectively declare a bidder ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be award a contract financed by the Royal Government of Cambodia and /or Asian Development Bank respectively, if at any time determines that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent, coercive, collusive or obstructive practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
